Principal's Report

- Mural Update – Ananda Gonder has been awarded by the mural selection committee; Ananda is currently working on digital concept; next Tuesday the school district board will review and approve
 - Goal: start mid-March to unveil May 3rd at Open House
 - Budget 4000 Bid: 4750; The Martin family agrees with helping to fund the mural
 - Will discuss in future how to keep kids away from wall

 - Ensure the marketing around this clearly state that the money goes to patients
 - Try to end prior to the start of the Read-a-thon
- PBIS Positive Behavior Support to review all processes and ensure effectiveness and quality
 - Identifying Student Expectations throughout the day
 - Will create videos to shift thinking
 - Raider bucks store to be sunsetted after this year
 - Instead, incentive programs conducive to each age group
 - Identify what age group values and what does the behavior look like
 - Ticket system will be intact however used differently than today (TBD)
