## Principal's Report

- SBAC Testing
  - Ms. Southard starts tomorrow
  - 5th grade took the test before the break
- LCAP Community Survey – 100 responses in for Rescue Family; would love to get 200 responses; Request to send another notice via Social Media.
- Over summer projects include:
  - C-wing buildings will get new roofs
  - Front parking lot will get redone
  - Rescue is on the list to get new blacktops provided funds left over at the district
  - 5th grade will move from F to D classrooms
- 2019-2020 staffing is almost complete except PE teacher. Existing teacher is going FT at another school therefore Rescue will get FT PE teacher.
- TK is full, 3 K, 4 1st grade, 3 2nd, 2/3 combo, 2 3rd, 2 4th, 4/5, 2 5th

## President's Report
