Meeting called to order at 3:26pm

Dustin welcomed all to the new school year and had participants make introductions. He explained the purpose and duties of the Site Council.

Student Report:

- 1. Upcoming Events:
 - a. Kids Can Food Drive (10/26-11/13). All donations benefit the El Dorado County Food Bank.
 - b. Red Ribbon Week (10/26-10/30). Focus is on making good choices. Rescue is providing daily challenges for students, staff and families to focus on making healthy choices.
 - c. Book Fair (11/9-11/23) will be held virtually this year.

School Report:

- Dustin shared that the Rescue Union School District Board of Trustees voted on October 13th to have students come back to school in a traditional model beginning January 4th, 2021. School will be held from 8:55am-2:10pm daily through the months of January and February. If health and safety numbers continue to be favorable, The District will move to a fully traditional bell schedule beginning March 1st for the remainder of the school year. Dustin shared the updated 2020-2021 school calendar reflecting these changes.
- 2. The Rescue PTC will be holding a Halloween Drive Through Parade on 10/30 from 1:00pm-2:30pm in the car loop in front of the office.
- 3. Parent/Teacher Conferences will be held the week of 11/16-11/20. Teachers will send out Sign-up Geniuses so families can sign up for times that work best for them. Conferences will be held in person, but teachers will meet with parents virtually if in person conferences are a concern.
- 4. The Annual Read-a-thon is underway. The fundraiser has so far raised over \$9,000. All proceeds will provide support to students and teachers during this unprecedented time for school.

New Business/Action Items:

- 1. Dustin shared a draft of the school budget (At a Glance). He outlined the various pots of money that are used to fund items for our school.
- 2. Dustin held a discussion regarding the process for reopening in a more traditional manner in January. He shared a proposed bell schedule and discussed some continuations of the health and safety procedures. All students will be required to wear face coverings in school (TK-5th). The District and Dustin will begin providing communications after Thanksgiving to the community in preparation for the January opening. Dustin stated that he does not want to overload the community with communication and will work to limit communications to once a week or when absolutely needed.
- 3. Dustin will be reaching out to stakeholders for feedback in preparation for the January opening.
